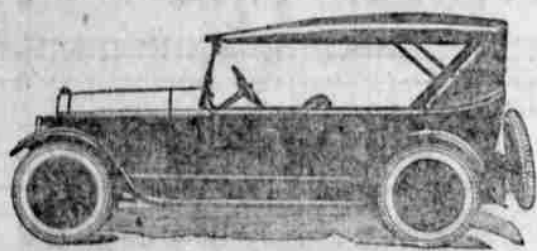

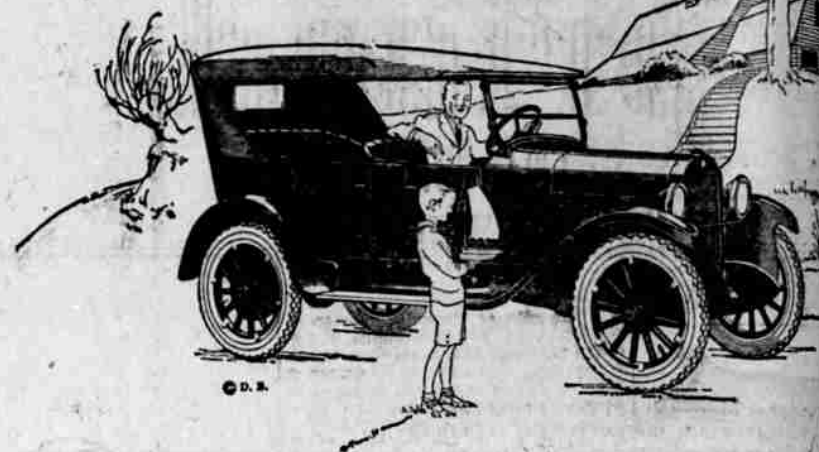

gon was the common mode of conveyance and a squeaky wheel would develop it usually meant days of delay in order to overcome this annoyance. The wheel would be removed and either left to soak in a pool of water until the wood had expanded or the entire rim would be shrunk until the wheel had tightened. The modern way to tighten loose spokes however, is an easy task and requires but a few minutes work.

The "village smithy" with his forge and anvil takes no part in this work today, according to auto experts, as it is an easy matter for the car owner to jack up the wheel loosen the hub bolts and pour in a few drops of "Spoktite" or some similar preparation between the flanges and spider of the wheel. After the spokes have well absorbed this liquid, the hub bolts are tightened and the operation is completed. The peculiar ingredients that are entered into this compound cause the wood to swell. It is claimed, tightening the spokes in the hub and felloes.

cific highway south of Toledo.

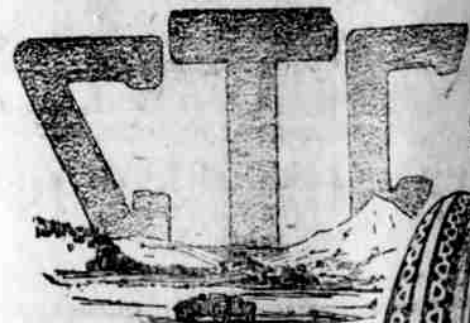
