

The contract for the construction of the kitchen and mess hall at the Soldiers Home was let yesterday by the state beard of control to Contrac-tor L. W. Metzger of this city whose proposal was in the sum of \$15,795. The building is to be reinforced con-crete and will house a modern kitchen, refrigerating plant and mess hall. It will be placed in the rear of the pres-cit puess hall, and the rooms now cut mess hall, and the rooms now occupied for kitchen and dining room will be converted into a waiting room and game room.






