Auto Driven by J. F. Mast Gons Over Grade on Coos Bay Highway Near Remote-Wife Sustains Bad Injuries

MARSHFIELD, June 25.—J. Finley Mast, aged 60, a cousin of County Judge Mast, was instantly killed and

his wife seriously injured when their
Ford touring car plunsed off the

Remote and fell between 75 and 160
feet to the rocks below.
The tragedy occurred when Mr.

the mountainside.
