LARD BEATEN ARGENTINE

Knocks Out Opponent 8th Round of Scheduled 12-Round Bout

MEBACK IS FAILURE

Shows Former Gameness Was Unable to Withstand the Terrific Attack of Younger Opponent

YORK, July 12.—Jack Meeback, 35, and Billy Firpo, 22, met in a heavyweight championship bout last night at the Waldorf Astoria. The event will be held in the Jersey arena. Meeback said he wanted to meet Firpo and was unable to do so. The official time for last night's fight was 100,000 people present, with 100,000 people in the audience. Meeback was knocked out in the eighth round by Firpo.

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Liberal Press Says Note Is Too Considerate of Feelings of France—Statements Regarding Ruhr Ignored
