GAVE INSPIRATION TO POET

Thoughtful Kindness of Elderly Couple Responsible for Lines That Have Won World Fame.

Sam Walter Foss, the author of the poem, "The House by the Side of the Road," was an enthusiastic traveler. On one of his trips through New England he came, at the top of a long hill, to a little unpainted house, set almost in the road. At one side was a signpost pointing to a well-worn path and a sign, "Come in and have a cool drink." Following the path he found in the side of the bank a spring of ice-cold water, above which hung an old-fashioned gourd dipper, and on the bench near was a basket of apples with another sign, "Help yourself." He found a childless old couple in straitened circumstances, with the rocky farm as their only source of livelihood. But it was rich in the delicious spring of water and an abundance of fruit, so a sign was placed guiding to the water, and from the time of the ripening of the first purple plum to the harvesting of the last red apple, a basket of whatever fruit might be in season was placed near, that anyone passing might rest upon the long hill and refresh himself. The old gentleman explained that they were too poor to give money, so took this way to add their mite to the world's well-doing.

The beautiful thought so impressed Foss that he immortalized with his pen the ideal life of helpfulness.

IS ANCIENT SECRET ORDER

Odd Fellowship Has Long Flourished, Though Its Foundation Would Be Hard to Trace.

The actual origin of the name is as obscure as the foundation of Odd Fellowship, concerning which all that is known is that the earliest lodge was the Loyal Aristarchus, which met in London in 1745. To this source may be traced the Manchester Unity, established in 1813, and now the largest friendly society in the world.

At the outset the order adopted a rule: "That any brother of the independent order who shall be guilty of neglecting any secret society of women or attending their meetings shall be suspended for 12 months for the first offense and for the second shall be expelled from the order forever."

The Odd Fellows, like other friendly societies, was illegal prior to 1850, and on many occasions was robbed with impunity. One of its officials applied to his own use about \$4,000, which had been subscribed for the relief of sufferers through the Irish famine, and yet the society had no legal redress.

One of the big buses which takes crippled school children to and from school was waiting with its load of little ones beside a street car which was taking on passengers. British Women on Railroads.

Nearly 30,000 women are employed by the railways of the United Kingdom. Of this total the majority, of course, are employed in clerical work. A considerable number, however, are engaged in work not usually done by women. Nearly 300 are employed as laborers and a thousand more are classed as "mechanics and artisans." There are women signallers, station-masters, foremen, policemen, engine cleaners, oilers and greasers, and at least one who is engaged in the dangerous and arduous work of a switchman.

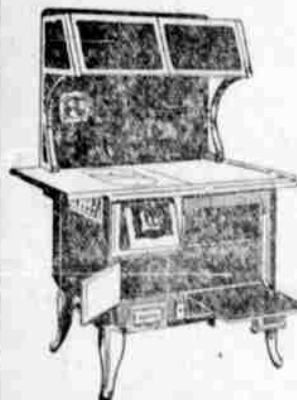
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DUNDEE LOOKS GOOD AGAINST CRIQUI

NEW YORK, July 26.—The iron jaw of France and the rubber ball of America will meet at the Polo Grounds tonight to decide the featherweight championship of the world.

Eugene Criqui, with the serious face and crooked jaw, will defend the title that he won some time ago, with a great victory over the venerable Johnny Kilbane, against Johnny Dundee, one of the greatest living fighters that ever swung a glove.

Dundee, one of those Italians who sent the poets into reveries about the fighting blood of Caesar, will be at least the sentimental favorite. He has a tremendous following in New York and his partisans are not confined to the Italian colony.

Criqui proved in the Kilbane fight that he is a worthy champion and a great fighter. He had proved it before, in Europe, but Americans are skeptical about the class of fighters on the other side who helped to give the gallant French war hero of Verdun an impressive list of knockouts.

Dundee is, beyond doubt, one of the greatest little fighters that ever lived. He has been nearer to various championships than any other fighter, with the possible exception of Charley White. He has beaten them all, and in most of his fights he was forced to give away pounds and pounds of weight to his opponents.

Various opinions have been expressed on the outcome of the fight, but there is one that should carry weight because he has met them both and knows both.

Johnny Kilbane, former featherweight champion, leans toward Dundee as the victor, and he predicts that Criqui will have the fight of his life on his hands.

"Criqui is a great fighter," Kilbane says. "He keeps coming in all the time and he is always hitting. He hides behind an upraised shoulder, much after the style of Dempsey, and he is hard to reach at the jaw. He is not an extremely clever fighter, but he has a heart that keeps him coming back all the time. I had no trouble outboxing him and I found that he was easy to hit."

GRAND TETONS

Opening of the new southern gateway to Yellowstone Park will make this season the greatest in the park's history, according to Horace Albright, superintendent. Traffic the first two weeks was fifty per cent greater than a year ago by this route.

The new gateway is at Lander, Wyo., the extreme western tip of the Chicago & Northwestern Ry. and runs over the new extension of the Rocky Mountain highway for 150 miles through a primeval jumble of towering mountains, precipitous canyons, rivers, lakes, brooks and rapids, to the southern boundary of the park. The land is mostly forest reserve and Indian reservations, with Wild West ranches here and there, and innumerable streams alive with trout.

As Lander's only rail line ends there, business men of the section have instituted a regular line of 12-passenger automobiles to carry tourists from Lander over the trail.
