NEW YORK, Oct. 30.—"We dropped you twice and we'll do it again next year," the defeated Giant players hurred at the victorious Yankees in good natured joking after the last game of the world's series.

The two rival clubs occupied adjoining dressing rooms under the stands at the Polo Grounds and although there had been some bad spirit shown on the field during the series, the players were friends again after the last game.

The spirit in which the Giants accepted their defeat was interesting, inasmuch as it plainly expressed the opinion of the losing players that the two New York teams would win the major league pennant again next season and play against each other in the fourth straight series.

More thoughts of such a thing may cause consternation in the cities of New York where the opinion has already been expressed that the monopoly of this city on the series is killing interest in baseball. To argue the question about what effect the continued success of the New York teams is having upon baseball in general, is beside the present point.

The Yankees and the Giants feel sure that they will win the pennant again next year and from a casual glance right now over what they will have to beat, it is reasonable to assume that the two pennant winners are not outclassed for the 1924 races.

During the winter, when changes may be made to strengthen rival clubs, just remember that under the present conditions the Giants and the Yankees will have a lure for a reward that no other major league club can offer to encourage its athletes.

New York players can confidently expect another million dollar series if they win the pennant and no other team in baseball can have its manager gather the players around the table in the spring and say:

"My good young boys, if you win the pennant and the world's series you will be enriched by \$7,000 over your salary. If you win the pennant and lose the series, you will still get \$5,000."

The players will get more money next year, if the series is played in New York than they received this year, if the weather is better, because the attendance failed of capacity twice because of threatening weather.

There is no question that the hope of the rich reward from the series brought the Giants staggering thru to the National League championship last season and the same bag of gold drive some sense into the heads of the temperamental Yankees when all other means had failed.

SEEKS DAD WHO QUIT HOME FOR WOMAN IN 1886

**Forgiving Daughter Willing
to Welcome Back Her
Erring Parent.**

LEFT WIFE AND BABE

**Put Faith in Clairvoyants
to Help Her Locate
Missing Father.**

BINGHAMPTON, N. Y., Nov. 1.—Memories of long ago pull at the heartstrings of Mrs. Emma Fiske. They reached out across 37 years and vivify her love for her missing father. She has begun anew the search for Jasper Rivenburgh her father who eloped with a girl in 1886, leaving behind him his wife and two children. Intent upon finding her father and bringing him back to Binghampton to live with her, Mrs. Fiske has consulted clairvoyants in all parts of the country, she said today.

The enigma of Rivenburgh's sudden disappearance remains as baffling now, after many years of search, as it was in the beginning, when on one day he brought home a young woman introduced her as the new housekeeper, and the next day fled with her, after locking his wife and two children in a bedroom.

Daughter Forgives.
His daughter forgives him now, just as his wife forgave him before she died, within a year after his disappearance of a broken heart. The daughter knows, she said today, that her father meant no wrong and that influences were brought to bear upon him which forced him to the rash elopement. She wants him back home and promises a welcome for him if he will come to her here.

There was no suspicion of Rivenburgh's plan to elope. His disappearance the next day came with such a shock that his wife never recovered from it. After it was learned the Rivenburghs and the girl had gone away together, the police were summoned and Detective S. Foster Blacklong since retired followed the runaway couple for a short distance.

Defied Officers.
Rivenburgh's escape to an adjacent county meant safety for him. The detective confronted him once, but because he did not have what was then called the "questionary papers" he could not bring Rivenburgh back to Binghampton.

Then Rivenburgh dropped out of sight. His trail was covered completely. His wife Mrs. Fiske's mother, was stunned by the tragedy. Seven years after her death the first word from Rivenburgh came by mail. It was a letter written from Wheeler, Ia., to his wife. He explained his disappearance, begged forgiveness and said he wanted her to take him back. His daughter wrote to him that her mother had died the year after he left. No more was heard of him. As the years passed Rivenburgh's daughter began to think that her father, as age came upon him, might need her care. Her mother's last words had been an injunction to forgive and forget the elopement. She was willing.

She began a series of interviews with clairvoyants which have just come to a climax.

The latest information received by Mrs. Fiske from a clairvoyant is that her father is on a farm not far from Binghampton, probably near Montrose. She has asked the Binghampton police to aid in the search.

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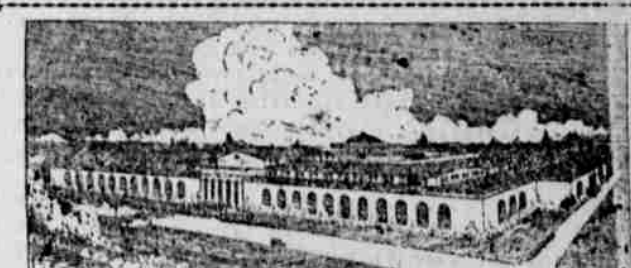
