LOCAL CANNERY PRODUCTS BEST

Representative of Wholesale Grocery
Firm in City to Buy Large
Part of Output of the
Roseburg Cannery

E. C. Getty, representative of Sussman, Wormser and company, wholesale grocers of San Francisco, was in Roseburg today. Mr. Getty is one of the company's largest buyers and spent the day conferring with A. J. Geddis, manager of the local cannery. Sussman, Wormser and company is one of the leading distributors of the products of the Roseburg cannery.

This company has been buying canned fruits and vegetables here for several years, and have been disposing of a large portion of the cannery's output with their high class products. This season they have purchased over seven thousand cases of apples alone, the fruit being packed under their special brand. The San Francisco concern is now working out a market for canned prunes and are meeting with good success.

They are also handling all the canned broccoli and cauliflower put up by the Roseburg cannery. The company does not question the price placed by the cannery on its goods, as they consider quality only and are glad to pay liberally for this class of product. This company on a recent government contract bid 27 cents more per can than a number of packing corporations, but the government, taking into consideration the fine quality of fruit put up by the Roseburg cannery, readily paid the difference in price and accepted the local apples.

The California concern is distributor for all kinds of fruit, much of it going to foreign markets, and the output of the Roseburg cannery is finding a ready sale.

This is the only cannery among the list furnishing the San Francisco firm with canned goods that the pack is not personally inspected by a representative of the company. The excellent co-operation given them by Mr. Geddis does away with this feature and the goods shipped from here are always found to be of the highest quality and well packed.

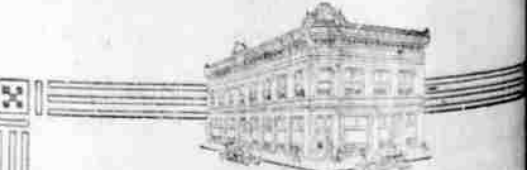
