S. 415), the timber on the following lands will be sold Dec. 28, 1923, at the check-in, in at public auction at the United States Forest Service office, Eugene, Oregon, the highest bidder at not less than the appraised value as shown by this notice, sale to be subject to the approval of the Secretary of the Interior. The purchase price, with an additional sum of one-fifth of the amount thereof, becomes the sum due, and may be paid in full or in part at time of sale, money to be turned if sale is not appraised, otherwise payment will issue for the timber which must be removed within ten years. Bills will be received from citizens of the United States, associations of such citizens, and citizens of the United States under the laws of the United States, or any state, Territory or District thereof only. Upon application of a qualified purchaser, the timber on any legal subdivision will be offered separately before being included in any offer of larger units.
