WIDER USE TO BE SOUGHT FOR OREGON FARM PRODUCE

Oregon produces a moderate surplus of staple commodities for which there is a relatively unlimited established market, and a very large surplus of certain specialties which form the major source of the nation's food supply and for which it is necessary to develop a consumption demand.

A study of this problem, with suggestions for meeting it will occupy an important place in the program of the agricultural economic conference to be held at O. A. C. January 23 to 25.
