SAYS GOVERNMENT IS A THREE-RING CIRCUS

ST. LOUIS, April 11.—That the government is being conducted as a sort of three ring circus, with the law makers too busy getting on the front pages of newspapers and satisfying personal ambitions to attend to legislation, while business suffers, was the statement last night of Mrs. G. Marvin, New York attorney, and president of the American-Russian chamber of commerce.

Marvin while addressing the Central Mississippi Valley trade conference, announced that he and Colonel W. N. Haskell former director of American relief administration in Russia would leave for Russia in the summer to conclude private contracts for the exploitation of the resources of that nation "before every other country in the world beats the United States to it."

"We shall attempt to obtain by

private methods what our government should obtain by treaty. Marvin praised the department of commerce, directed by Secretary Hoover, as the "best administration in the history of the nation."

CITY CLEAN-UP STARTS MONDAY

Residents Urged to Start Collection of Rubbish and Refuse.

TRUCKS ARE HIRED

City to Put on a Number of Auto Trucks to Complete Collection of Refuse in Two Days.

The annual spring clean-up scheduled for Monday and Tuesday the 14th and 15th, will be the most complete and thorough the city has ever had if the plans of Mayor Rice and the City Beautiful Commission are fully carried out. All residents of the city are being urged to clean up all old rubbish from their yards, and have it placed in sacks, boxes or barrels or some similar container and placed on the curb line along some paved street Monday morning. If all of the residents of the city will only give complete cooperation, there is no doubt but that the plans will be executed in a manner which will be well pleasing to all.

The city is renting a number of big auto trucks for the two days and the rubbish will be collected as rapidly as possible. Unless the refuse is piled out on the curbs early Monday morning it is apt to be missed, a fact which residents should bear in mind.

All property owners are asked to collect all articles which they wish to have carted away, on either Saturday or Sunday, but they should not be put out for hauling until late Sunday night or early Monday morning, as it is not desired to have the city littered up over Sunday.

The rules provide that all rubbish must be in suitable containers. Loose refuse will not be picked up. Sacks, boxes, or barrels will serve the purpose. The trucks will not go off the pavement, but will visit every paved street. The containers, therefore, should be placed along the curbs of such streets. It is believed that the city beautiful idea has taken such a firm grip this year, that there will be few persons who will disregard the appeal for a most thorough clean-up this year.
