The H. S. French Transfer Company has just completed and placed in use a huge furniture van, which is to be used for local work and long hauls. The body was designed by V. S. French and was constructed by employees of the company. It is planned with a view of obtaining the greatest utility, and can be used for a great number of purposes. When loaded with furniture the van has heavy pads which line the interior to prevent marring or scratching the contents. It has side doors for loading from freight cars or buildings where backing up to the entrance is not practical. This siding material is of waterproof construction and the entire frame has been built to withstand heavy wear and usage, the construction being of a durable type. The whole truck has been painted an attractive color and makes a fine addition to the large fleet of motor vehicles operated by this concern.
