In his note to the league, Tchitcherine, who signed himself "People's Commissary for Foreign Affairs of the Union of Socialist Soviet Republics," declared that in the present international situation it is impossible in most cases to say which party is the aggressor. He contended that neither the entry into foreign territory nor the scale of war preparations can be regarded as satisfactory criteria. He insisted that hostilities generally break out after a series of mutual aggressive acts of most varied character.

For example, Tehitcherin said when the Japanese torpedo boats attacked the Russian fleet at Port Arthur in 1904 it was clearly an act of aggression from a technical point of view.

of view, but politically speaking it was an act caused by the aggressive policy of the Czarist government towards Japan, who tried to forestall the danger, struck the first blow at her adversary. "Nevertheless," he added, "Japan cannot be regarded as the victim because the collision between the two states was not merely the result of the aggressive policy of the Czarist government, but also of the imperialist policy of the Japanese government towards the cause.

Referring to the pact's authorization of regional agreements between groups of states, the Soviet government said it regarded local agreement between certain states as inevitable, but deemed it quite inadmissible that they should receive recognition from an international organization (meaning the League of Nations), which they should regard as beneficial in the prevention of wars.

the Japanese Government towards the people of China and Korea. The Soviet government considers, therefore, that it is absolutely impossible to adopt the system of deciding which state is the aggressor in the case of each conflict, and making definite consequences depend upon such decision."

Tchitcherine admitted that there are cases in which a state attacks another without provocation, and said that the Soviet government is prepared to make agreements with other governments to oppose attacks of this kind undertaken without due
