MINORITY REPORT ON SENATOR WHEELER

(Associated Press Leased Wire.)
WASHINGTON, May 19.—The federal grand jury in Montana was justified in returning an indictment against Senator Wheeler, democrat of that state, in the opinion of Senator Sterling, republican, South Dakota, who submitted a minority report to the senate today in his capacity as a member of the special committee which investigated the indictment.

Senator Sterling limited his report to the question of justification, declaring the question of the guilt or innocence of Senator Wheeler is not a proper subject of inquiry by the committee, but solely a matter for determination by the courts.

Senator Sterling asserted that Senator Wheeler's charge that the indictment was the result of a "frame-up" failed entirely of "proof."

MISSOULA, Mont., May 19.—Gaston B. Means, former employee of the federal department of justice and a witness in the senate investigation of former Attorney-General Daugherty, in this city today, refused to divulge his mission.
"I am friends of Senators Walsh and Wheeler of Montana," he told a newspaper inquirer. "That is about all I can say right now. At least I believe my activities of the past show I am a friend of theirs."

HIRAM RELEASES S. D. DELEGATES

SIOUX FALLS, S. D., May 20.—Senator Hiram W. Johnson has released the South Dakota delegation to the republican national convention from its obligation to vote for him for the party's presidential nomination, according to a message from Pierre, quoting John Sutherland, manager of the South Dakota campaign.

Mr. Sutherland announced today, the dispatch said, the receipt of a letter from Senator Johnson stating that he releases the South Dakota delegation "from any obligation to me at the national republican convention."

The South Dakota delegation will go to Cleveland unattached, Mr. Sutherland said.

AGREEMENT REACHED

TOKYO, May 20.—An official announcement confirming yesterday's informal statement that conversations between Governor-General Merin of Indo-China, and Vice-Minister Matsudari of the foreign office had resulted in an agreement looking toward expansion of Japanese commerce with the French colony was issued by the foreign office today. The agreement would grant, Japan in principle, most favored nation treatment in Indo-China.

The foreign office statement reiterates that economic matters only were discussed with the Governor-General.

particularly young cabbage, kale, broccoli, turnips, beets, radishes, tomatoes, and egg plants. The best control may be had by use of a repellent poison dust. This constitutes hydrated lime 80 parts and lead arsenic 20 parts, both materials should be of finely ground material and thoroughly mixed. Dust on plants liberally in the early morning while the dew is on the leaves. Repeat dustings at intervals of 10 days to two weeks. The local dealers of spray materials should be able to furnish the dust at reasonable cost. The broccoli growers especially should be watchful of this insect upon their seed beds.
