## IDAHO DEMOCRATS ENDORSING M'ADOO

ST MARIES, Idaho, May 21.—The Idaho democratic state convention early today adopted a resolution endorsing the candidacy of William G. McAdoo for the democratic presidential nomination without instructing that state's eight votes be cast for him. The action came as the climax to 12 hours of almost incessant contests which prior to the McAdoo endorsement fight had hinged on the candidacy of Robert H. Elder of Cour D'Alene, for re-election as national committee man.

The later contest resulted in Elder's selection over Asher B. Wilson of Twin Falls by a majority of 11 votes.

The democrats in congress were congratulated on having "successfully combated corrupt influences in government and the intrusion of special interests" and Senator Walsh and his associates were praised for their part in exposing governmental scandals.

Economic relief was covered in declarations for tariff revision, membership in the league of nations with reservations and the world court, economic cooperation with Europe and passage of the McNary-Haugen bill.
