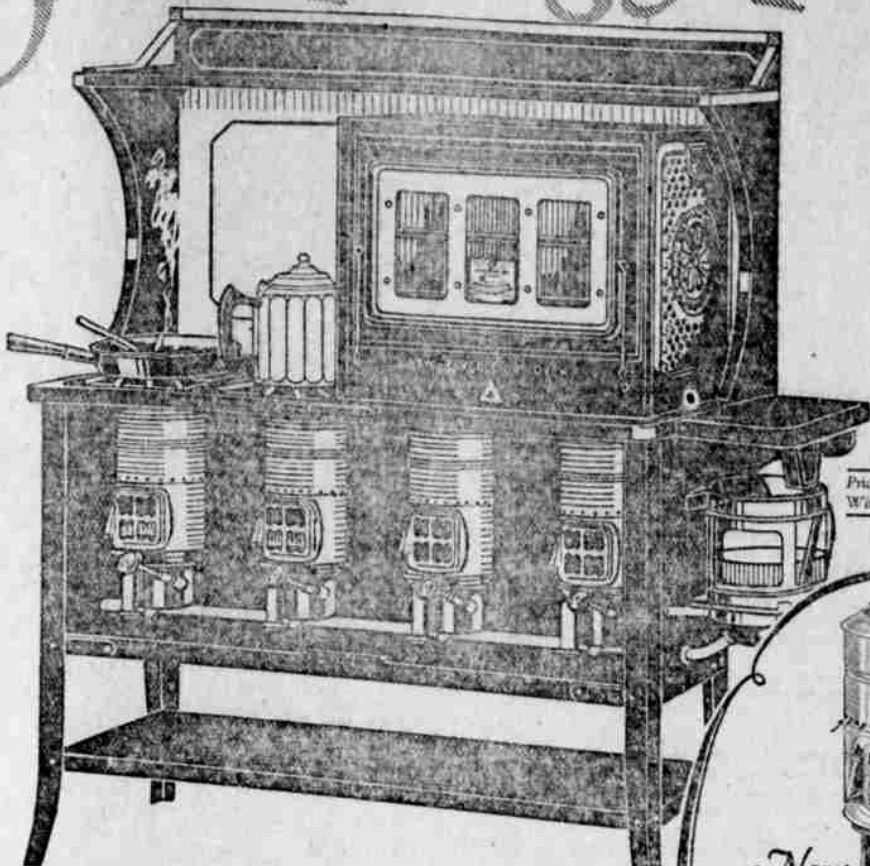

NO HARM FROM CHLORINATION

Method of Purifying Water
Does Not Cause Injury to
Human Beings.

TASTE IS OFTEN BAD

Disagreeable Taste and Odor,
However, Not Due to Chlorine in Water, Health
Officers State.

The continued dry weather is making the water problem a real issue in many communities. In Roseburg there is ample water to supply all that is needed for domestic purposes in spite of the fact that the rivers are lower than for many years in the past. As a result of this condition it is certain that within a short time the water will begin to take on a bad taste, owing to organic matter and many complaints will doubtless be made.

Much of this complaint is usually made about the chlorination of water, but such complaints have no foundation. The taste is caused by vegetable and organic matter in the water and not by the presence of the chlorine, which is used to destroy the germs of disease which might otherwise be present.

An excellent explanation of the use of chlorine in the water used for domestic purposes, and the effect of such purification is given in the following statement issued by the Oregon State Board of Health, in co-operation with the United States Public Health Service:

Water is an absolute necessity. No organic matter can grow, nor can any living being exist, for any length of time, without water. To secure an adequate and safe supply of this element is one of the first problems of a civilized community. In incorporated towns and cities, the responsibility for a safe water supply rests upon the mayor and city council.

Under our present conditions of civilization it is becoming increasingly more difficult to find a "natural" water supply that is safe. The problem must be met by sterilization. Of all the methods devised for the purification of water, chlorination is the most practical and efficient. It will be necessary therefore, for an increasing number of communities to install chlorination plants.

On installation of chlorination plants, city officials are frequently besieged with all kinds of complaints. People imagine that all their ills are due to the chlorine in the water. The conditions most frequently complained of are a disagreeable taste and odor, certain skin eruptions, cramps and intestinal disorders. That these are purely imaginary is proved by the fact that complaints continue to come in, long after chlorination has been discontinued.

Chlorine in the proportions used for the sterilization of water is harmless. Authorities agree that chlorine, in the proportion of two or three parts per million, produces no harmful effects on the human organism. As a rule, only a small fraction of this amount is used in the sterilization of water. Filtered water from lakes and rivers is sterilized by two or three-tenths of one part per million. Water supplies from wells and springs are sterilized by two-tenths to six-tenths of one part per million. Raw surface water is sterilized by five-tenths to one part per million. The average water supply in this country is sterilized by three-tenths to eight-tenths of one part per million.

Disagreeable tastes and odors are generally due to the presence of organic matter rather than to chlorine in the water. Undoubtedly, it is well to have a competent person in charge of the chlorination plant. As a matter of fact, however, water supplies are seldom over-chlorinated.

ANCIENT RIFLES FOUND IN CAVE

SPOKANE, Wash., June 26.—Nine ancient rifles, several of them possibly antedating by half a century the Civil War and believed to contain a message of historical interest, were discovered recently in a cave along the bank of the Coeur d'Alene river near Russell, Wash., 65 miles northwest of Spokane, by C. H. Fugh of this city.

The guns, which are muzzle-loaders, have been viewed by several persons credited authorities on early state history who declare that the oldest is at least 65 years old, while several are more than 100 years old.

William S. Lewis, a member of the Eastern Washington Historical society and author of several books on early northwest history, said the rifles were of the Civil War period and said:

"There is no record of a trading point," Mr. Lewis said, "but there were many Indian camps in the district during the Civil War, when the soldiers were often captured from the Indians and secreted there by the Indians."

Joseph Meyers of Meyers Falls, who settled in northeastern Washington in 1869, expressed the belief that the cave was placed there by some white settler, who became marooned during the Indian disturbances of 1876.

"The older rifles are of a make which was discarded by the federal company, and came back into general use by the Indians 25 to 30 years ago," Mr. Meyers said.

Discovery of the cave was made by Mr. Fugh in a peculiar manner. He was walking over the ground and unthinkingly delivered a kick against the side of the bank, which caved in and disclosed an opening. Penetrating the cave a short distance, he stumbled across the rifles.

According to Mr. Fugh, the cave contains numerous other relics, including pots, war implements and other materials. He plans to return to the scene, probably during August, for a more extensive investigation of the cache.

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SAMUEL M. HALSTON IS PLACED TODAY

Former Governor Of Indiana Lauded
For Record of Economy—Sug-
gested As Candidate

NEW YORK, June 26.—In an address of 225 words, twenty-seven words shorter than Lincoln's Gettysburg address, Fred Van Nuys of Indianapolis, today placed Samuel M. Halston in nomination for the presidency. Van Nuys emphasized Halston's ability as a vote-getter and his record for economy while Governor of Indiana particularly.

"As governor of Indiana he made an unparalleled record of economy and efficiency. He left \$5,000,000 in the state treasury, and the state out of debt for the first time in eighty-two years."

"As United States senator he has shown himself possessed of rare poise and purpose," said Van Nuys. "Had he been president of the United States during the long, trying months just passed he would not have remained stoical and silent. He would not have broadcasted silence to an outraged and impatient people, but would have led them with a dynamic and not a static spirit of Americanism. We need this man, from Indiana, at the head of the nation's affairs today. He is a rugged American of middle-western integrity, honesty, and of soundest common sense."
