FOUR INJURED WHEN RUM BOAT IS SHOT

(Associated Press Leased Wire.)
EVERETT, Wash., June 28.—Four men were seriously burned, three of them wounded, when a one-pounder shell from the coast guard cutter Arcata exploded the 400 gallon gasoline tank on the 36 foot launch M-775 off Skatet head near here, at 12:20 o'clock this morning.

The 400 gallon gasoline tank of the pursued craft blew up when a shot from the Arcata's one-pounder gun went through it, and the motorboat, which was 36 feet long and speedy, took fire. The Arcata, bringing the injured to Seattle, left a boat's crew to try to save the launch.

Ralph O'Leary, the least injured of the four persons aboard the motorboat when the Arcata appeared 500 feet away said that the party was on a hunting trip, but was running without lights. He asserted that the Arcata opened fire without warning with her one pound gun and four or five rifles. He was struck by a bullet at the wheel.

SEATTLE, June 28.—Four men were severely burned today when a one pound shot from the Coast Guard cutter Arcata, seeking rum smugglers, pierced the gasoline tank of their motor boat in Mutiny bay, 18 miles north of here. Three of the four men were wounded by bullets.
