LONGVIEW CHOSEN FOR LUMBER MEET

(Associated Press Leased Wire.) WASHINGTON, July 24.—Longview, Wash., a modern city of 15,000 population so new it is designated on only a few maps now in circulation, has been selected as the summer meeting place of the board of directors of the National Lumber Manufacturers' association. The meeting July 30 and 31 it was announced here today will precede the formal opening of what is said to be the world's largest lumber mill, which will have a capacity of more than a million feet a day.

Longview brought into existence on the Columbia river within two years to serve as the mill's urban center and bearing the name of the company's head, H. A. Long, of Kansas City, is described as being completely equipped with water, sewerage, and other systems, fire and police departments, a hotel of 200 rooms, a daily newspaper, eight miles of concrete and 25 miles of gravel pavement, a golf course, up to date stores and more than 1,000 residences. It has a harbor for ocean going steamers and also is reached by a new 20 mile standard gauge railway.
