YOUTHFUL SLUGGER MAKES FIELD HOT

CHICAGO, Aug. 22.—From a lowly bench warmer to one of the brightest stars in the national league is the remarkable rise of Hazen Cuyler, youthful outfielder of the Pirates.

Cuyler today finds himself battling Roger Hornsby, second base star of the Cardinals, for the batting championship of the league. He batted 11 hits in his last five games, giving him an average of .383 and is trailing twenty points behind Hornsby, who is topping the list with .410.

Zack Wheat, Brooklyn veteran, is third with .366. The averages include games of Wednesday.

Cuyler's chance came by accident when Max Carey, the Pittsburgh veteran was injured. When Carey returned to the game, Manager McKeehan of the Pirates found Cuyler's services indispensable.

Jack Fournier of the Dodgers, leading home run hitter of the league is basking in the total of 25.

Veterans of the American league are gradually crowding their way toward the top. Following the example of Eddie Collins of the White Sox, Ty Cobb, pilot of the Tigers; Tris Speaker, leader of the Indians, and Harry Heilmann, Detroit slugger, have worked themselves up among the leaders.

Babe Ruth who continues to top the regulars, dropped from his 400 mark of a week ago to 396. However, he still has a comfortable lead over Bob Fark of the White Sox who is in second place with 360. George Sisler fell out of the 300 class and is way down in the list with an average of .298.

Ruth failed to increase his record of 38 homers.

ILLINOIS FLOOD IS SPREADING DAMAGE

PEORIA, Ill., Aug. 22.—The greatest flood in the history of Spoon river valley is tearing its way through Fulton county today, wrecking nearly every wagon and railroad bridge in its path, destroying farm buildings, drowning livestock and devastating thousands of acres of crops.

Flood waters threaten to sweep road and wagon bridge connecting this city with Galesburg and points west, near Seville. Hundreds of farmers, forewarned of the water sweeping down the valley are fleeing to the hills with their household effects, many of them in row boats.

Bernadotte, a village on the river Canton is being abandoned by residents who are fleeing to high points.

GIVES PURPOSES OF BOY SCOUT COUNCIL

Asked this morning for a general statement concerning the purposes of the Boy Scout Council now forming in Douglas county, President V. T. Jackson said that its purpose were all possible of being summed up in the question: "If the Boy Scout idea is a good thing for the whole citizenship of the United States, why not let us have more of it? Why stop when we have reached only ten or twelve per cent of the boys which seems to be about the limit without some organized form of effort?"

The idea of the Boy Scout Council is simply that of systematizing the attention of the men of the community to the training of boys. The Scoutmaster always has been and always will be, about all there is to successful scouting, so far as the work itself is concerned. The difficulty always is to get enough Scoutmasters. According to Mr. Jackson, who expresses himself as heart and soul in favor of this big movement, the business men of the various civic orders, an communities within Douglas county who have been giving consideration to the organization idea, realize that without providing some training, some experienced assistance, it is useless to expect that there will be as many leaders as there should be for the boys of the county, or that they will be as well equipped as they should be. It is desired to combine the communities of the county in a council that will give attention to the training of all the boys, and employ an executive to serve jointly all the communities.

As soon as a sufficient number of communities affiliate to justify applying for a charter, that step will be taken. Roseburg, Reedsport, Yoncalla and Drain, are already represented in the provisional organization, with Oakland in prospect for action a little later. Reedsport has already underwritten its share of the financial responsibility.
