LENINGRAD, Russia, Sept. 12.

—Runsia is sending a scientific expedition to Wrangell Island, headed by the well-known Geodetic expert, Davidoff, chief of the navigation department of the Russian government for the ray said. The expedition will journey in a specially equipped vessel and remain on the Island for several months, during which Davidoff and his assistants will chart the const line and interior and make a complete survey of the material resources and other features.

It is already surressted bern that the island be rechristened Lenin Island in memory of the creator of Bolshevik Russia.

MOSCOW. Sept. 19.—Seriet officials express satisfaction over the success of the expedition on the armed transport Krasny Oktiabr (Red October) in planting the red flag on Wrangel Ioland, off Northern Siberia, taking formal possession in behalf of the Soviet republic. They believe this action will settle the status of the island, which has been in dispute for more than a half century. They regard it as an important base for a wireless station and supply base in event of war.



the recent republican primary by a plurality of 1731 votes over Senator E. L. French of Vancouver, according to official figures from the county auditors in 39 counties of the state.

The official figures, collected by the News-Tribune here, show that Hartley received 58,686 votes and Fronch 56,955.

The official count of the various county auditors in the state shows but little change over the unofficial returns tabulated by The Associated Press.

The official count, which include a few precincts not preciously reporting the absence vote and the correction of minor errors, gave Senator French a gain of 721 votes over the unofficial returns.
