LENINGRAD, Russia, Sept. 19.—Russia is sending a scientific expedition to Wrangell Island, headed by the well-known Geodesic expert, Davidoff, chief of the navigation department of the Russian government for the far east. The expedition will journey in a specially equipped vessel and remain on the island for several months, during which Davidoff and his assistants will chart the coast line and interior and make a complete survey of the material resources and other features.

WALES SPENDS BUSY DAY ON LONG ISLAND

(Associated Press Leased Wire.) SYOSSET, N. Y., Sept. 18.—The Prince of Wales is anxious, it was learned today, to return to the United States at a later date to visit the great industrial centers and farming communities, to become acquainted at first hand with industrial conditions and to meet American workmen and women.

As one of his acquaintances has put it: "Whatever he undertakes he does with intelligence and vigor, whether it be riding and dancing, as on this visit to Long Island, the main object of which was to encourage the British polo team in its efforts to win the cup, or whether it be attending public functions in his own country, presiding at meetings of charitable institutions such as King Edward's hospital fund, or attending to the affairs of London's largest hospital, such as Guy's and St. Bartholomew's with which he is closely connected."

LA FOLLETTE SPEAKS IN NEW YORK CITY

(Associated Press Leased Wire.) NEW YORK, Sept. 8.—Senator Robert M. La Follette, in Madison Square Garden tonight told the first audience he has addressed since the announcement of his candidacy for president, that he did not intend "to be diverted from the discussion of the vital economic issues of the campaign by the foolish and preposterous assertion of our opponents that in some way we as progressives desire to weaken or impair the provisions of the constitution of the United States relating to the federal courts."

ADJUSTMENTS ARE MADE ON FIRE TRUCK

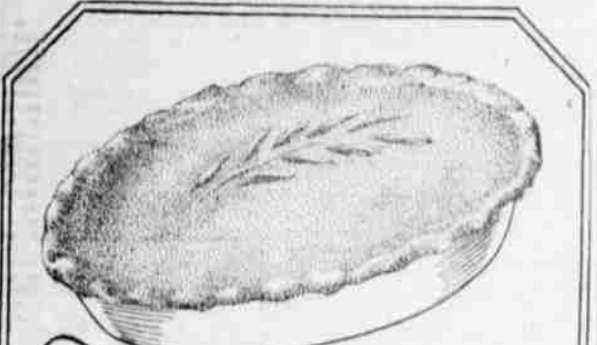
COLONEL HARTLEY OFFICIAL CHOICE

(Associated Press Leased Wire.) TACOMA, Sept. 19.—Colonel Roland H. Hartley, of Everett, was nominated for governor in the recent republican primary by a plurality of 1731 votes over Senator E. J. French of Vancouver according to official figures from the county auditors in 39 counties of the state.

The official count, which includes a few precincts not previously reporting the absentee vote and the correction of minor errors, gave Senator French a gain of 632 votes, making a net gain for Senator French of 89 votes. That unofficial returns gave Senator French 56,234 votes and Colonel Hartley 58,054, a plurality in favor of the nominee of 1820 votes.
