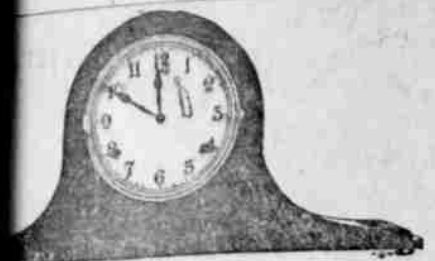

WINDLESS RAIN STORM IN CALIF.

(Associated Press Local Wire.) SAN FRANCISCO, Dec. 5.—California was host today to a windless rain storm that promised to drench the whole state. Fairly heavy rains were experienced from San Francisco north last night, but the head of the storm is expected to arrive from the north Pacific tonight.

The storm area is the greatest of the season to date, covering virtually all of the north Pacific. A feature is the absence of winds, the gale warnings which were posted along the coast when the storm was first sighted yesterday, being taken down this morning.

ROBBERS GET \$17,000 SAN FRANCISCO, Dec. 4.—Three messengers for the Pacific Gas and Electric company, on their way to a bank, were held up in front of the company's offices

and robbed of \$17,000. It was reported to the police today. The messengers, from the cashier's office of the company had just left the building when three young men stepped from an adjoining building and covered the messengers with pistols. Obtaining the packages, the robbers ran through the yard of an adjacent church.

One of the packages, the company stated, contained \$25,000 in securities and this was recovered from an alley where the men had dropped it. They got away with the other packages, which contained \$17,000 in cash. The men were seen to get into an automobile after they had dodged around the church. A man in another car tried to pursue them but was deterred by the waving of pistols. One man on a motorcycle started after the robbers' car, which disappeared in the downtown traffic.
