MEDFORD BEATS ROSEBURG

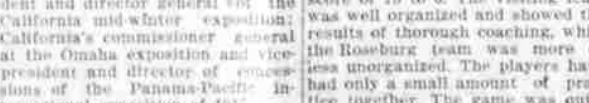

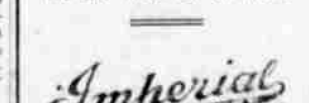

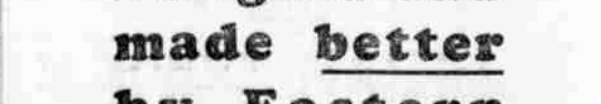
