### OIL MEN HOLDING KANSAS CITY MEET

(Associated Press Leased Wire)  
KANSAS CITY, Mar. 18.—Duplication in marketing cost with resultant wide margin between the tank car and tank wagon prices for gasoline, was held accountable for conditions detrimental to the oil industry in an address prepared for delivery before the American Oil Men's Association convention by Paul Herrickson here today.

He suggested as possible solutions reductions in the number of filling stations and sale of gasoline on a sliding scale, depending on the volume of their monthly consumption.

He declared disbelief in the efficacy of "doping" gasoline and urged that distinction be given to the product rather by "jealously guarding the quality" of gasoline, and by giving it a trade marked name.

A saving of \$10,000 in the American oil industry annually may be effected through a broad application of simplification and standardization, R. M. Hudson, chief of the division of simplified practice of the United States department of commerce said in an address prepared for presentation at the convention.

Mr. Hudson said that amount represented almost as much as the total investment in the petroleum industry, which he stated has considerable progress in standardizing pipe, drilling, equipment and sales.

Mr. Hudson said that the Hoover committee of 18 prominent American engineers on Waste in industry had disclosed that waste in six typical cities was close to 50 percent.

### NURMI FORCED TO STOP; BAD STOMACH

(Associated Press Leased Wire)  
NEW YORK, Mar. 18.—Paavo Nurmi ran to three world records over the protests of the Connecticut Athletic Union, and a disordered stomach last night, but in the end the stomach and Willie Ritola, the light haired marvel's brother-Finlander, were victorious.

Illness came to Paavo as he raced away from the field in the 5,000 meter event, one of the features of the Knights of Columbus track meet. Four laps from the end he staggered, shook his head, and held his hand to his stomach. He struggled on, striving to regain his stride, as Ritola, who had been 30 yards behind, raced past him. An other circuit and he left the field.

Before the race Nurmi had essayed a meal of meat which had not had time to digest properly.

Little Jole Ray of Chicago, mightier than ever before, awaited the battle at a mile late in the evening, but was denied. But a phantom Nurmi must have run at his side, for he broke the tape in time that equaled the world record held by the Fin, four minutes and 12 seconds.

It was a sensational battle between Lloyd Hahn, the Boston A. runner, who has set a record for three quarters of a mile and the Midget Ray.

For the distance he ran before being forced to quit, Nurmi hung up the following records:  
Distance 4,000 yards; time 10:31; former time 10:41 5/8; made by Ritola.  
Distance 4,000 meters; time 11:30 4/5; former time 11:55 3/5; made by Ritola.  
Distance 2 1/2 miles; time 11:36 1/5; made by Ritola.
