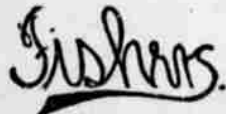

NEWMAN JAILED FOR CONTEMPT OF COURT

H. I. Newman of Yoncalla was today ordered committed to the county jail until he pays a judgment claimed by Ruth Wilkinson, the unmarried mother of Newman's child. Newman was arrested several years ago upon complaint of the girl's mother, and was ordered by the court to pay \$20 per month for the support of the child. This was later reduced by mutual consent to \$15 per month, but Newman, the court was told today kept reducing the monthly payments until they were only \$1 per month. Information of this state of facts was conveyed to the court and Newman was ordered to appear for contempt of court and upon a hearing being held this morning was ordered confined to the county jail until the amount of the judgment is paid. The amount claimed by the mother for delinquent payments was \$346.

CAUSE MINISTER'S DEATH IS PROBED

HOT SPRINGS, S. D., March 24.—An investigation into the life of Reverend Robert E. Tarleton to determine a motive for the death of the clergyman, who died of poisoning, was instituted by authorities today after surveying testimony which discounted any theory of suicide. Chemists at the state university at Vermillion analyzed the pastor's stomach after an autopsy failed to reveal a trace of heart disease by which it was believed at first that he died and then that poison caused his death. A survey of the minister's life indicated he had no known enemies, was popular in his community and successful in his work. He was found dead in his garage January 29.

against hanging. A California law forbids hanging persons under 18 years. California citizens have always opposed the hanging of women of any age. When the jury is completed defense counsel will advance the plea that Miss Ellingson is suffering from a mental condition bordering on insanity. The girl has confessed to the killing. She has told of the quarrel with her mother over new dresses and undesirable acquaintances to whom her mother objected, of the argument which led to the fatal shot and of taking all the money in the house and walking away over her dead parents' body to remove the companionship of men friends. Before Dorothy killed her mother the Ellingson home stood divided because of the daughter's activities. Her father had left after a disagreement with her mother when Ellingson objected to the hours and company the girl was keeping. Mrs. Ellingson defended her daughter. His wife dead, his daughter in jail, the father was in court yesterday and caressed his girl when she was led in for trial. Beside him stood his son. After Miss Ellingson's arrest he refused to permit her to attend the funeral of her mother, but he now hopes for some mitigating circumstances which may save his daughter from a felon's cell.
