NOTICE is hereby given that the undersigned will, up to 7:30 o'clock P. M. of April 14, 1925, receive at his office in the City of Roseburg, Douglas County, Oregon, sealed bids for the purchase of negotiable serial coupon bonds of School District No. 4 in Douglas County, Oregon, in the sum of \$165,000.00. Said bonds will be in denominations of \$1,000.00 each, dated May 1, 1925, and maturing as follows: 6 bonds to mature May 1, 1926; 6 bonds to mature annually on May 1st of each and every year thereafter including May 1, 1933; 11 bonds to mature annually on May 1st of each and every year thereafter including May 1, 1940; 10 bonds to mature annually on May 1st of each and every year thereafter including May 1, 1945. SENATORS ASK FOR DATA ON ALLEGED TRADE LAW BREACH

(Associated Press Leased Wire.)
WASHINGTON, Mar. 25.—Sixteen members of the senate have joined in a request that the federal trade commission supply them with any information it may have, "regarding the nature of commissions being formed abroad by American business, commercial and financial firms and corporations in alleged violation of the anti-trust laws."

In a letter to the commission, made public today, the senators themselves cited allegations that "American business interests are establishing themselves in many countries in combination with similar business interests in those countries." They asked for any information the commission has as to this and particularly as showing "whether in any cases American goods are sold cheaper to foreign customers as a means of maintaining the prices of such goods manufactured in the United States than to American consumers."

The request was addressed to the federal trade commission as the agency charged with administration of the Webb-Pomerene act which the letter said "is designed, as we understand it, to help American business corporations and to find a market for their products abroad."

The letter was made public in a statement by Senator Ladd of North Dakota, who announced that, in addition to himself, it was signed by Senator Fletcher, Frazer, Howell, Harrell, Kendrick, King, La Follette, Mayfield, McMaster, McKellar, Norris, Sheppard, Shipstead and Wheeler.

"No greater blow can be inflicted upon a club than the loss of its star shortstop. THINKS CHICAGO CLUB WILL PLACE HIGH IN LEAGUE

LOS ANGELES, Mar. 25.—Belief that the Chicago National league baseball club will place higher in 1925 than it did last year was expressed here by William Killefer, Cub manager, in commenting on the outlook for the ensuing season. "It is yet too early in the year to predict the pennant chances of the club," Killefer declared, adding, however, that he was confident the Cubs would finish "near the top."

TRAIL OF ROBBER FOR KILLING OPENS

HARTFORD, Conn., Mar. 25.—Nineteen new talesmen were summoned and were scheduled to appear in Hartford superior court today at the second day's trial of Gerald Chapman, notorious mail robber and jail breaker, who started a fight yesterday, for his life, charged with the murder of Patrolman James J. Skelley in New Britain last October.

From these additional talesmen, drawn last night after five jurors had been obtained out of 86 talesmen examined, are expected to come the seven other jurors needed before the actual trial of the picturesque bandit may be started.

Throughout the court proceedings yesterday Chapman assumed a pose of indifference.

NEW STAMPS BEING ISSUED TO MEET NEW POSTAL RATES

A new 1-cent stamp has been put on sale in Washington, D. C., according to word received by C. S. Heald, postmaster. The stamp carries the portrait of the late President Harding but is otherwise of the same design as the ordinary one-cent stamp.

Embossed envelopes of the denomination also are being printed. In this case, however, the picture of Washington is used.

The stamp was created to meet the new rate for advertising and circular matter which is set at 11 cents by the new postal rates which go into effect April 15.
