DAKOTA FIRES UNDER CONTROL AFTER ATTACK

(Continued from page 1.)

tensive damage. Crippled wire communication made it difficult to run down reports from the southern fire zone.

Approximately 150,000 acres of prairie and hay lands in the northern part of the state near Wapala were swept by the flames before fire fighters succeeded in extinguishing the blaze today.

The list of dead in unconfirmed reports mounted to four today, all in the Southern Dakota-Nebraska area.

VALENTINE, Neb., Mar. 27.—Unconfirmed reports reaching here this morning stated that a school teacher and two children were burned to death several miles south of Crookston, Neb., in the devastating prairie fires which have been raging in this vicinity since last Wednesday.

Starting near the Rosebud Indian reservation in Tripp county, South Dakota, late Wednesday, sweeping eastward along the stream the blaze laid waste three small inland towns, threatening numerous villages along the border in the two states causing an unestimated amount of damage and the death of perhaps four persons.

Tuthill, South Dakota, where four persons are believed to have lost their lives, was reported to have been destroyed by the onslaught of the flames.

Women and children at Cody and Nenzel were routed out of camp when the towns were threatened while all male citizens engaged in a successful effort to avert destruction of the villages.

Those reported burned to death at Tuthill were an Indian woman, her two small children and another child. No other reports of loss of life had been received here, although it is feared that additional casualties might be revealed in a check up of the outlying ranches, many of which were razed of all buildings.
