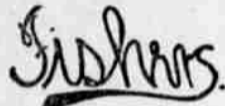

RUSSIAN GENERAL WARNS PEOPLE TO PREPARE FOR WAR

(Associated Press Special Wire.)
MOSCOW, April 7.—General Frunze, commissar of war, warned the Russian people to be prepared for war, which he believed may come unexpectedly as in 1914. Addressing a large gathering of supporters of the Russian volunteer air fleet last night, the war chief declared that the recent meeting of the general staffs in the Baltic states at Helsingfors, together with the murder of two communist officers on the Polish border, showed that Russia must be prepared to meet attack from any quarter at any moment. Although he believed the entente countries were too occupied with economic affairs to engage in immediate warfare, he did not rule out that the possibility of attack from them in the future. Karl Radek, who has exercised an influence in the Bolshevik world second only to the influence of Trotsky, appears to be destined to follow the form Soviet war minister into political oblivion. The all powerful central controlling commission of the communist party passed resolutions yesterday roundly condemning Radek's attempts to create a factional strife within the German communist party and he is warned that if he continues to oppose the present central committee of the German communist party he will be dismissed from membership in the Russian communist party. Radek, Heinrich Brand and Herr Thalhammer, former leaders of the German communist party, are forbidden to participate in the work of the communist internationale. Yesterday's decision, which was taken at the instance of the central committee of the German communist party, was endorsed at a plenary sitting of the communist internationale. Radek's differences with the German communist party date from the time of the failure of the Bolshevik revolution in Germany, an event which figured largely in last year's party campaign against Trotsky.

FINANCE PLAN PLACED BEFORE FRENCH SOLONS

constraint," was the way M. De Monzie puts it. "If the French capitalists understand the system and patriotically respond to the call of the government, it will work without the slightest annoyance or interference in private matters. On the contrary, if they make constraint necessary it will be resorted to." Declarations of the income tax will be taken as a basis for obligatory subscriptions to the forced loan in cases where the capitalists fail to come forward voluntarily. Subsequently these declarations will be verified if there are reasons to suspect their exactitude. Contributions to the forced loan may be spaced over a period of 5 years and the contributors will receive three percent "rentes" which are perpetual bonds and never mature. Declarations for this loan will be checked by the government. This levy would be used to reduce the public debt, according to expectations. M. De Monzie's plan in raising the limit of the note issue and at the same time raising the limit of loans from the Bank of France to the treasury is looked on by many financial experts as a sound measure. "Principles at the bottom of the whole scheme," said M. De Monzie, "are the maximum of option on the part of the capitalist and a minimum of constraint. If a capitalist so desires, he can, before his subscription, make a declaration of his fortune, which will make any intervention on the part of the government to ascertain his wealth unnecessary." The minister gave it to be understood that this measure would be resorted to only in flagrant cases of dodging by a capitalist of his obligations under the new law.
