ARMY OFFICER WHO KILLED WOMAN TO PLEAD INSANITY

MANILA, April 8.—Lieutenant J. S. Thompson, young army officer, today pleaded insanity from his cell here in which he placed the responsibility for his act in shooting Miss Audrey Burleigh to death upon an extreme mental aberration.

This allegation of his reasoning powers, the lieutenant said, was due to his to which he has been subject, and the situation in which he found himself on Sunday morning, when he shot Miss Burleigh to death while they were riding in an automobile near Manila, was made acute by jealousy over the attentions showered upon the young woman.

On previous occasions, Lieutenant Thompson said, he found himself in the same condition. The statement indicated that insanity would be offered as a defense when Lieutenant Thompson comes before a general court martial this week on a charge of murder in the first degree.

The shooting took place after Miss Burleigh took part in an amateur theatrical at the Army and Navy Club on Saturday night. Lieutenant Thompson objected.

STORM "BREWERS" LEAVES GOVERNMENT SERVICE

(Associated Press Local Wire.) WASHINGTON, April 8.—Chas. Brewer, long the storm center in the controversy as to whether there was fraud and duplication of government bonds, has been separated from the department of treasury, where he was a special agent. It was said his work was considered completed.

Brewer was appointed by President Harding to conduct the investigation into the government engraving plant where there was a wholesale dismissal of employees. Treasury agents made an inquiry and subsequently many of those dismissed were reinstated.

Brewer finally took his case into the courts and to congress. A majority of an investigating committee of the house held there had been some duplication in bonds. Treasury officials, however, and a minority of the committee refused to subscribe to the findings.

NAVY RECEPTION AT FRISCO DRAWS NO RACIAL LINES

(Associated Press Local Wire.) SAN FRANCISCO, April 8.—The city by the Golden Gate set a bit of its cosmopolitan aspect before the personnel of the United States grand fleet today in the shape of a reception and entertainment by the Chinese community in San Francisco's noted Chinatown.

HEARST WILL ADD RADIO SERVICE TO HIS NEWS CHAIN

(Associated Press Local Wire.) LOS ANGELES, April 8.—The Los Angeles Examiner in an article published this morning says that William Randolph Hearst, publisher, and Joseph M. Schenck, motion picture executive have formed a partnership for the purpose of launching a nation-wide radio broadcasting program.

Four powerful broadcasting stations, the paper says, will be erected in as many cities. Three of these, New York, Chicago and Los Angeles, have been selected and the fourth will be the natural complement enabling the four stations to blanket the United States with a daily program of news and entertainment.

Construction will be started as soon as location and equipment can be obtained.

As a result of the agreement reached among the scientists as to the fundamental causes of corrosion, a corrosion institute will be created here and co-operative work to study the ravages of corrosion will be undertaken by the institute with the support of both the users and producers of metal products.

"This institute" it was announced, hopes to solve this problem in a practical manner which may result in saving aggregating hundreds of millions of dollars annually to the people of the United States alone.

POPULARITY OF DOLLAR BILL IS TREASURY WORRY

(Associated Press Local Wire.) WASHINGTON, April 8.—The rapidly growing popularity of the dollar bill has become a problem to treasury officials. The government is faced with the necessity of either greatly expanding the capacity of its printing plant to meet the public demand for circulation of the unit of paper currency, or inducing the public to be more economical in its use.

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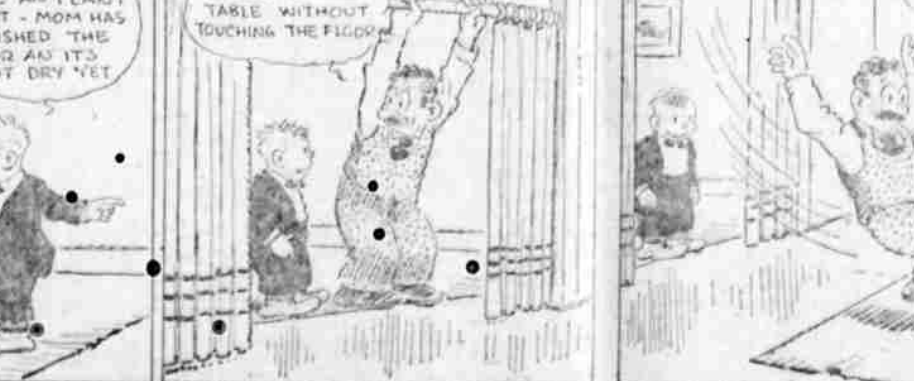
