VON HINDENBURG HOPES STILL TO BE OF SOME USE

(Associated Press Leased Wire.)
HANOVER, Germany, April 10.—The first campaign utterance of Field Marshal Von Hindenburg, as the presidential candidate of the conservative-nationalist bourgeoisie bloc, is contained in a brief letter to Dr. Karl Jarres, who was selected as the bloc's candidate in favor of the field marshal.
"You can imagine that the decision to become your successor was not easy for me," Von Hindenburg writes. "My feeling of duty alone, and not personal inclination persuaded me to accept the nomination when it was offered. God grant that if my election should really come about, I may at the end of my life be still of some use to the beloved Fatherland."

LARGER LEARNING SCOPE FOR SALEM INDIAN SCHOOL

WASHINGTON, April 10.—In accordance with its policy for increasing educational facilities for Indians, the Interior department today announced that two of the government's Indian institutions, the Salem boarding school near Salem, Oregon, and the Chillicothe boarding school in Oklahoma, near Arkansas City, Kansas, are to be enlarged to afford a complete high school education for the students. The grades in each school will be increased soon from 10 to 12.

VESSEL MISSING 5 DAYS FAILS TO ANSWER SIGNALS

(Associated Press Leased Wire.)
NEW YORK, April 10.—Radio stations and ships at sea which for five days have filled the air with calls for the steamship Arcturus, carrying scientists on a deep sea oceanographic expedition, today continued their efforts. The expedition, today continued their efforts. The expedition has not been heard from since March 29, when the captain reported that all was well 200 miles south of Panama. The vessel had been giving her position daily by wireless.

The Arcturus is the largest vessel ever fitted out especially for deep sea exploration. It is equipped with every type of fishing nets. The crew number 35 and with 14 scientists and two passengers, the total on board is 51. There was a feeling among some scientists that the expedition might be on the verge of some important discovery and that in order not to be premature, all information from the ship was being withheld.
