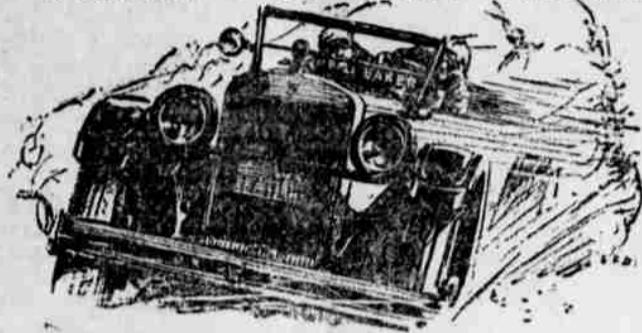

San Francisco to Los Angeles—439 Miles in 8 Hours 57 Minutes

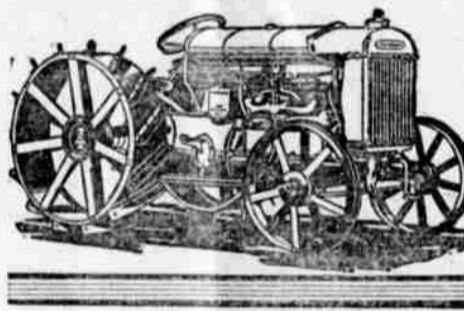

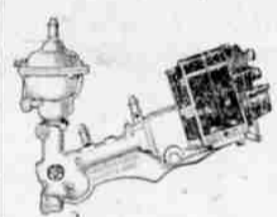
