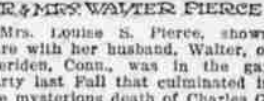

SOVIET RUSSIA TURNS ITS BACK TO LEAGUE CALL

(Associated Press Local Wire.) GENEVA, April 20.—Soviet Russia has refused to participate in the forthcoming conference on control of the traffic in arms.

The refusal was contained in a stiffly worded telegram from foreign minister Tchitcherin, pointing out that the Soviet government had repeatedly proclaimed its negative attitude toward the League of Nations recently organized.

Referring to the invitation to attend the arms conference, the Soviet foreign minister said: "In the present case the Soviet government finds it impossible to collaborate with the League in study of a question which implies interference by the League of Nations in the internal affairs of the Soviet republic."
