ORVAL LANGENBERG AND FATHER HELD ON BOOZE CHARGES

Orval Langenberg, who resides east of the city, was arrested late yesterday afternoon charged with possession of liquor, and was fined \$250 following his plea of guilty to the charge, the fine being paid. He was arrested by county officers, who found three one-gallon jugs of wine stowed in the rear of his Ford coupe. The officers seized the liquor and the auto, and will confiscate the car under the provisions of the Oregon law.

The officers went immediately to the Langenberg home, and there arrested George J. Langenberg, Orval's father, who is also charged with possession. They state that they found where he had dumped out a large quantity of liquor following the arrest of his son, and before the visit of the officers. However, they found a container in which there was about a quart of wine left, and this was held to be sufficient to warrant a charge of possession.

George Langenberg was arrested on a similar charge several months ago, and was confined to the county jail for a short period, but physicians found that his physical condition was such that he could not stand further confinement and he was given a release.

Great Skill Required in Training of Hawks

Various kinds of hawks were trained for the purpose of falconry. Each bird had its own style of flying and its own particular method of taking the quarry, opinion as to which specific kind of hawk was the best being divided.

But of them all none was more generally popular than the noble peregrine—a first-rate flyer, docile, tractable and extremely courageous.

Capt. W. E. Knight, M. C., says in the pastime which once played so great a part in the lives of the English, and to which reference is made in the works of such authors as Shakespeare and Scott.

For grouse hawking the female, being a heavier, stronger bird than the male, is generally used, for she is better fitted to take an old and strong grouse. She it is who is called "falcon", the male being known as the "hercel" because he is one-third less in size than the female.

The art of falconry consists in personating a naturally fierce, wild bird to do for her owner exactly what she would do in any case in the wild state—in short to display at close quarters the amazing powers of flight with which she has been equipped by nature.

If she should be so successful in her flight as to strike her quarry, she dispatches it immediately—and in most professional manner—a sharp bite at the base of the skull and it is all over. On the other hand, if the hawk fails to come up with her quarry—is perhaps out of flow, beaten in the air—she fails completely. The intended victim escapes, doubtless rejoicing in the blow, and it is up to the good console falconer to recover his erring charge as soon as he can.

Farmer Has Advantage Over Dweller in City

HERMAN HIRSCHBURG DIES IN PORTLAND

(Associated Press Local Wire.)
PORTLAND, Ore., April 30.—Herman Hirschberg of Independence, Ore., banker and business man of the Willamette valley and founder and president of the First National Bank of Independence, died today at the Imperial hotel, where he had been ill for about a week. He had been in poor health for some time.

With him when he died were C. A. McLaughlin, vice-president of the Independence bank, and H. M. Walker one of the directors.

Hirschberg came from Germany as a boy to New York and worked in a tin shop there. In 1872 he moved to Independence and set up a tin shop. He was at that time hardly able to speak English.

By thrift and industry he laid the foundations of fortune and in 1879 founded the First National Bank of Independence. He was identified with financing of innumerable development projects in Polk county. He built the railway between Independence and
