PROJECT TO CONSTRUCT 250 MINES OF R. R. IS FILED

(Associated Press Local Wire.)
WASHINGTON, May 7.—A project for constructing 250 miles of new line in central Oregon, was filed today with the interstate commerce commission by the Oregon Trunk Railway, a corporation controlled by the Northern Pacific, Great Northern-Burlington group. No estimates of cost were included.

The projected line will run from Bend, Oregon, in a general southerly direction 170 miles to Klamath Falls, via Bonanza and Olean. In addition 80 miles of additional main line would be built through northward from Klamath Falls along the west side of Klamath Lake and returning to the main trunk again at a junction point called Skookum.

The line would open an avenue of transportation for very large timber tracts, the application said, and in addition would be some traffic from agricultural and grazing interests. It was further said that the Oregon Trunk was affiliated with other railroads which operate 27,000 miles of line and that these corporations were prepared to finance the extension.

There is pending before the commission a petition by the Oregon public utilities commission which asks that railroads serving Oregon be required to build a large amount of new extensions in the central and eastern sections of the state. The Oregon Trunk proposal filed today in part covers the routes on which the Oregon commission has sought to force new construction.

YREKA, Cal., May 7.—The expenditure of approximately \$250,000 for thousands of acres of land in the Klamath River region within the past few weeks, which became known here yesterday has given rise to the belief in many quarters that it presages the extension of transcontinental railway lines from Reno, Nev., to Yreka, Cal., where they will join with the line of the Northwestern Pacific Railway Company.

The proposed extension, it was reported here last night would be from Reno and thence to Klamath Falls and Hornbrook and Eureka. The purported holding company is the California City and County Land Company of San Francisco. The prevailing opinion here is that the interests behind the acquisition of the land is the Chicago, Milwaukee and St. Paul Railroad Company. Most of the property has been transferred to the California City and County Land Company. The purchased properties include the D. M. Horn ranch, the Robert L. Ferral ranch, the Cook and Smith ranches and thousands of acres in the Weverhauser Realty Company's holdings.

DANCE PERMIT IS GRANTED TO TAVERN

Under the new dance law, Mr. Malanson might have had some difficulty in continuing that form of entertainment, as the new law requires that the person to whom a license is granted must have been a resident of the voting precinct for a period of one year preceding the license. The permit granted is good for the remainder of this year.
