"RESOLVED that the Common Council of the City of Roseburg deems it necessary and hereby proposes to improve Short Street from the north line of Sykes Street to the south line of Spring Street, in the City of Roseburg, Oregon, in the following manner:

First: By grading said street to the proper sub-grade. Second: By paving the roadway of said street twenty-four feet in width with reinforced concrete pavement.

Third: By constructing sub-drains, if necessary. Fourth: By constructing street monuments. Fifth: By laying vitrified sewer pipe, if necessary. Sixth: By constructing catch basins, if necessary. Seventh: By constructing concrete curbs.

The entire cost of said improvement, including engineering, interest and all other expenses which the City of Roseburg would not have incurred except for the making of said improvement, shall be assessed upon the property especially benefited thereby, as provided by the Charter of the City of Roseburg, Oregon, and in accordance with the petition of the property owners to be benefited thereby, and no part thereof shall be paid by the City of Roseburg.
