### C. H. BAILEY SHOWING NEW VARIETY CHERRY

Three years ago the Bureau of Plant Industry, of Washington, D. C., sent a small cherry tree to Dr. C. H. Bailey, suggesting that he test out the variety, which was said to have originally come from Spain, as it might be adapted to this locality. This suggestion was followed. Dr. Bailey grafted the little tree on a wild cherry, and this season the tree fruited for the first time. The cherries, resembling Royal Ann or Centennial, is ripening now. While not so large as either of above varieties, its unusual sweetness makes it desirable. The new variety is sweet like the Centennial, very firm, and will undoubtedly prove a good shipper for that reason. Coming on very early, it will prove a good commercial variety for this section, as it can be shipped two to four weeks earlier than most any other of the sweet sorts grown.
