MIRACLE MAN OF FRANCE TO BEAR DOWN ON TAXES

(Associated Press Lead Wire.)
PARIS, June 10. — Finance Minister Caillaux today told the finance committee of the Chamber of Deputies that he intends to obtain from taxation alone all the necessary funds to cover all budget expenses, without recourse to loans. When England and the United States are convinced, France is making serious efforts toward internal taxation, they will be better disposed for terms in the settlement of inter-allied debts, he declared.

M. Caillaux said a foreign loan might be floated but that it was most important and urgent to show England and the United States that France earnestly desires to balance her budget and settle the inter-allied debts. Caillaux declared he was seeking a formula to avoid the increase of paper franc circulation.
