ATTACK STOREY OF STEPHENSON ON GIRL TOLD

by H. C. Stephenson, aided by Earl Elms and Earl Gentry, has been given to Judge Fred K. Hines of the Hamilton circuit court for consideration in determining whether the three men shall be admitted to bail pending their trial on a charge of murdering her.

Marshall Oberholzer repeated his sister's story of taking poison in a hotel at Hammond, Ind., following the alleged attack by Stephenson and also told the young woman's version of Stephenson's actions when he discovered she had sought to end her life.

"What was said about a hospital," asked Eph Luman, chief of defense counsel.

"I do not remember," replied Oberholzer, "she said Stephenson said she must go to Crown Point (county seat of Lake county, in which Hammond is located) and get married. He stuck a revolver to her heart when he said it."

"She said, 'What would I want to marry you for?' and she said Stephenson replied, 'You can use my name.'"

Dr. Kingsbury, who had preceded the brother as a witness, testified that Miss Oberholzer was in possession of her mental faculties when the alleged dying statement was made. He gave practically the same story of the attack, as was given when he testified at a coroner's inquest in Indianapolis, following the young woman's death.

Miss Beatrice Spratley, nurse who attended Miss Oberholzer, testified today that there were several lacerations on the young woman's body. One laceration upon the left breast was infected, she said.
