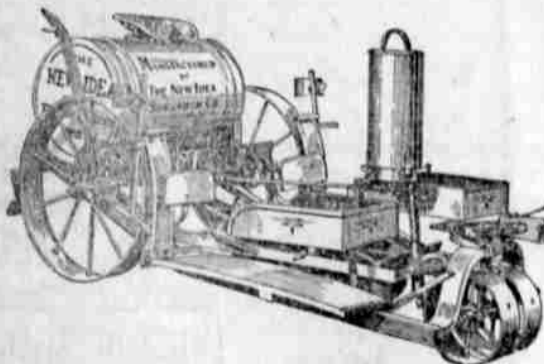

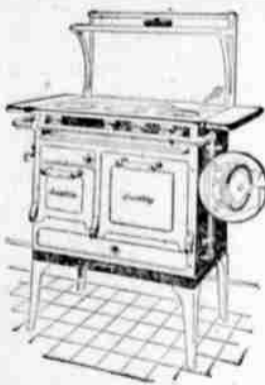
INSTRUCTION IN LIFE SAVING URGED BY THE RED CROSS

E. H. Carroll, field representative of the American Red Cross, is in Roseburg today meeting with the local officials and other interested in the life saving work of the organization. The Red Cross is giving a great deal of

time and attention to life saving work through swimming, and hopes that a local program may be worked out in conjunction with the national effort being put forth. If a local program is adopted, it will probably be through the Boy Scouts. It is hoped to work out a system whereby swimmers may be put through a course which will gradually bring them through the life saving tests to the positions of examiners where they in turn are recognized instructors in life saving and swimming methods. Many communities are fostering this educational effort, while in others the swimming instruction is supported by individual organizations. The Red Cross is trying to arrange a series of institutes each year, where the swimming instructors may be given advanced work, which they in turn can pass on to the members of their classes. One such institute was held in Seaside, Oregon, this year.

Mr. Carroll states that an effort is being made to interest the adults in the proposition so that swimmers already experts, may be qualified as life savers and examiners and aid in imparting the knowledge to the boys and girls of the community.






