TOKYO, Aug. 25.—Dr. K. Sugimoto, a rice expert attached to the Tokyo Nutrition Laboratory, one

of the three special scholars of the Rockefeller Foundation, said that one of his missions abroad would be to teach the people of the United States "how to eat rice." He has been making a special study of the nutritive value of rice for the past five years and has experimented on 30 persons.

POLICE OF ULSTER AND FREE STATE UNITE IN RAID ON MOONSHINERS

BELFAST, Aug. 25.—Moonshiners in the south of Ulster have lost the protection which formerly was accorded them by the border line, across which they used to flit when hard pressed on one side or the other.

The Ulster constabulary under command of Inspector Robinson, and the Monaghan Civic Guards, under Chief Superintendent Murphy, recently carried out a joint raid on an 18-mile front. It was the first time the rival police forces have cooperated in such a manner. Together they carried on their activities for eight hours and thoroughly routed the stills.

COOPERATIVE SOCIETIES GROW Apace IN RUSSIA

WASHINGTON, Aug. 25.—Co-operative Societies in the Soviet Union have grown in the last few years to a membership of 22,000,000 reports gathered by the Russian Information Bureau here show. The Cooperatives' membership in all other countries is given

as 8,000,000. The government, it is said, takes not part in the business processes of the Cooperatives except to facilitate credits and assist in extending their capital.

Foreign trade carried on last year by the Cooperatives for their members is shown to have amounted to about \$30,000,000. The Consumers' Cooperatives, foremost in importance, now includes 24,516 societies, with 42,000 shops and stores and 8,000,000 shareholding members. The business turnover last year was reported to have been \$701,000,000.

Next in importance to the Consumers' Cooperatives are the agricultural Cooperatives with 45,000 societies and 4,000,000 peasant members. Their business turnover in 1924 was \$318,750,000.

In addition to these two, other Co-operative societies include home craftsmen embracing pottery makers, weavers, metal workers, painters and other artisans; housing, building and renting; local credit; timber industry and hunters and trappers.
