PAYMENT MADE FOR REPAIR OF FIRE ENGINE

Differences Between Council and Distributors Settled Last Night.

DAMAGE EXPLAINED

Pumper Standing on Hillside Failed to Get Oil to Bearing—Lack of Instruction Claimed.

The bill for the repair of the city's fire truck, which burned out a bearing at a fire last March, was ordered paid last night by the city council, after reaching a compromise with the company. At the time the big Stutz pumper was delivered to Roseburg an engineer was sent here to instruct the fire department in the use of the machine. Shortly after his departure the truck was used at a hillside fire and a bearing was burned out, and it later developed that the oil pump on the truck is so located that oil does not get to the bearings when the front end is down hill. As a result of this condition a connecting rod bearing was burned out and one cylinder badly scored. The Howard-Cooper corporation, through which the machine was purchased, sent two mechanics to the city to make repairs and submitted a bill covering the cost of the parts and the expenses of the mechanics. The city refused to pay, claiming that the department was not adequately instructed, as was agreed upon in the contract. At the meeting last night Mr. Nelson, the company's representative, agreed to bear the cost of the mechanics' expenses, asking the city to pay only the actual cost of the broken parts. Upon this basis the council ordered payment.

Last night's session was a busy one, and quite lengthy.

A complaint was received from G. V. Wimberly, who protests the appearance of a fire hydrant installed on East Lane street. The water main was only a few inches under the surface of the ground, and when the hydrant was installed it stuck up so far into the air that it became unsightly, he claims. The committee on fire and water was ordered to investigate.

H. C. Darcy filed a petition stating that he has caused the street in front of his property to be graded and asking that he be allowed to bond the same. The street paving gives the fire department access to a hydrant, and is a decided improvement. His petition was granted.

The street committee advised the rejection of the petition asking for the paving of Harvard avenue as the petition lacked sufficient signers.

The committee on fire and water was ordered to employ a deputy fire truck driver. Four applications have been received so far.

The marshal was instructed to center sidewalks built on the west side of the Hunter building on Sheridan street.

REPORT GIVEN OF HEALTH UNIT WORK FOR QUARTER

The Douglas County public health unit has been doing a great deal of work during the past three months. Dr. Bell has summarized the activities in the following narrative report:

Jan. 1, 1925 to Sept. 30, 1925 shows a decrease of over 27 per cent in the number of cases of contagious diseases as compared with 1924. 219 cases in 1924 against 251 in 1925.

Among the most serious of children's diseases, whooping cough, measles and diphtheria this year show a striking decrease. 208 cases of measles in 1924 only 5 cases in 1925. 27 cases of whooping cough in 1924 against 8 in 1925. 11 cases of diphtheria in 1924 only 3 in 1925.

The Health Officer made 142 general inspections, inspected 15 dairies, investigated 50 water supplies, took 119 water samples, made 21 sanitary investigations, 28 nuisances abated, made 56 cultures of diphtheria, 7 blood tests for typhoid.

He also gave 16 lectures or talks to 496 people—2536 pieces of literature distributed, 120 press articles, 120 printed, and 6 exhibits were made.

In administrative work the Health Officer held 248 conferences, sent out 1215 letters of advice, answered 1548 telephone calls, and travelled 13,635 miles in Douglas County.

The Health Officer made 280 visits to the County Home, 242 home visits, 16 visits to the County Jail, 122 visits to the hospital, performed 62 operations, treated 425 patients, made 36 investigations, examined 17 pri-

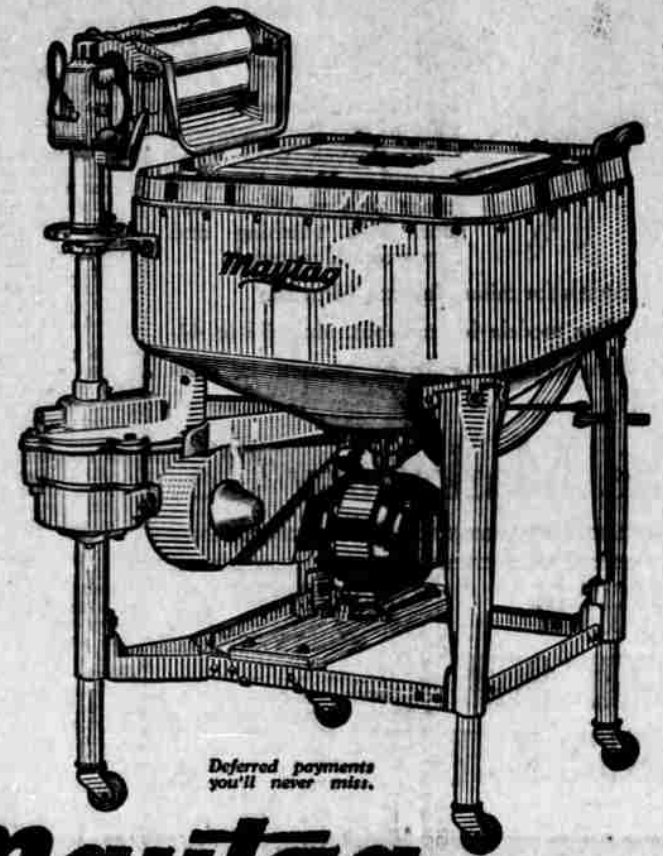

WILL IMPROVE TROUT HATCHERY AT ROCK CREEK

A number of important improvements are to be made at once at the Rock Creek trout hatchery, according to T. H. Hill, superintendent, who was in Roseburg for a short time yesterday. All the trout fry at the hatchery have been distributed, Mr. Hill says, and the ponds are now empty. He now has over 500 brood trout on hand and will start taking eggs the last of December or first of January.

Work is to start at once enlarging the ponds and constructing a badly needed feed house. The present wooden dams will also be replaced with concrete, and it is also possible that the commission will authorize the enlarging of the flume, as the hatchery is at present backing in water, only a larger flume being needed, however, to convey the necessary amount of water from Rock Creek.

DEAL A FOOT FOR PURCHASE POWER LINES OF COAST

KLAMATH FALLS, Ore., Oct. 6.—Negotiations are under way for the purchase of the entire holdings of the California Oregon Power company by the H. M. Hyllesby company of Chicago, according to authentic information received here today from both San Francisco and Chicago.

The sale price, if pending negotiations are carried through, will be in the neighborhood of \$20,000,000. Acquisition of the holdings of the California Oregon Power company is sought by the Hyllesby company as part of an enormous program by which it seeks to obtain power holdings from northern Washington to southern California. Its combined projected purchases total in the neighborhood of \$100,000,000.
