Interests that will afford tonnage
for railroads in addition to timber
in the Klamath country, also other
parts of the state, demanding trans-
portation lines to aid development.

Shoupe said the Southern Pacific
first extended credit to R. E. Strahorn
but eventually bought 3,000 of the
6,000 shares and took an option.

Control of the common stock in
the N. C. O. was finally obtained
for \$1, he said, but the Southern
Pacific agreed to take over \$750,000

He also stated that the great
700-acre mill site purchased by the
Weyerhaeuser Timber company was
along the Southern Pacific and that
his railroad was going to fight for
this new business.

He said he thought the line from
Crane to Odell through Central
Oregon, proposed by the Oregon
public service commission is not
justified by the traffic offered, and
that it could not give to southern
Oregon the transcontinental service
that could be furnished by the
Southern Pacific Alturas cut-off
over the Modoc Northern.

Lower Rates, Less Profit.
James H. Mulcahy, assistant
freight traffic manager of the
Southern Pacific, testifying late
yesterday, said that the completion
of his company's Eugene-Klamath
Falls line would result in lower
rates between Portland and the
Klamath region, because of the
shorter haul. If the Oregon Trunk
were permitted to enter the Klamath
Falls region, it would have to reduce
its rates also, in order to get business,
and this would lower the estimated
earnings of the Oregon Trunk
on the extension, he said. He
declared that the proposed new
trans-continental outlet via Alturas
would put Portland in a favorable
position to compete with San Francisco
and Sacramento in Northern California
and Nevada.
