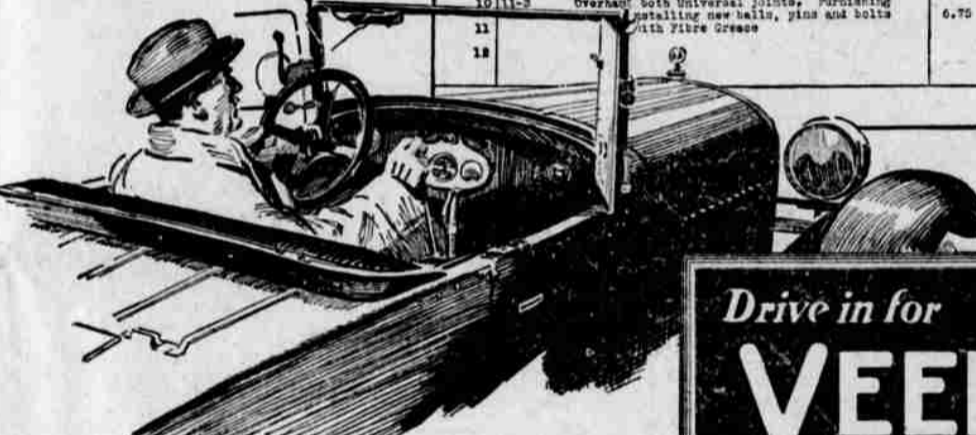

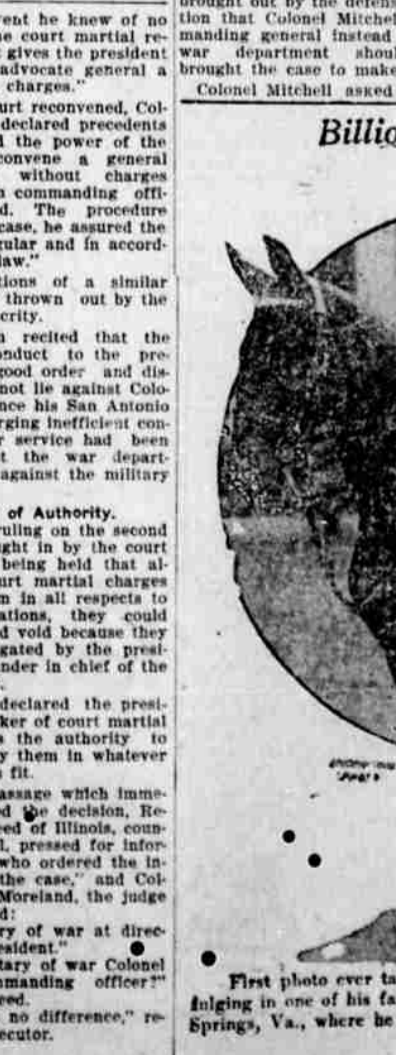
BOOZE BLOCKADE IS ON TODAY
