JAIL AND COURT HOUSE ARE HIT BY GRAND JURY

tain that they would have unanimously endorsed our recommendations for the earliest possible relief of the present congestion and fire danger. We join preceding Grand Juries in recommending that the County Court submit to the voters of Douglas County at the next general County election the question of the ed-

viability of the early construction of a combined court house and jail by direct taxation. A tax of six mills for one year, plus the present court house fund, will fully build and equip such a building which will be adequate for the needs of the county for years to come. If the taxes can be spread over two or three years, it would be advisable.

We realize that the regular recommendation of Grand Juries along these lines has become a matter of sport and joking, and we ourselves have smiled at the regularity of these recommendations. Our inspection today has convinced us that this is not a matter to be taken lightly. Within the Court House are the most precious documents owned by the people of Douglas County, their records of title. The County Jail must house human lives. The safety of those records and those lives is a matter of grave importance to Douglas County. We respectfully submit that this recommendation is entitled to the serious consideration of every taxpayer of Douglas County.

We have examined into and disposed of all matters coming before us and now stand ready to be adjourned at the pleasure of the court.
