EUGENE, Ore., Nov. 12.—Gene Shields, star guard of the University of Oregon football team, is out of the game for the rest of the season with a broken ankle, sustained in practice Tuesday. Beryl Hodgen, halfback, is suffering with a sprained ankle, and may not be used again this year.

These two accidents have put a slight crimp in the outlook for Saturday's game here with the O. A. C. football team, but apt substitutes are in the two places made vacant by the injuries, and hard practice work goes on.

Indications are that the homecoming crowd which will witness the game will be the largest in the history of football in Eugene.

CORVALLIS, Ore., Nov. 12.—A duel is expected Saturday when Wes Schulmerich and Lynn Jones meet on the scrimmage line in the annual O. A. C. University of Oregon football clash. Schulmerich who plays at half on offense, but defensive full back is a past master at backing up the line and is a line punger himself of the quality that has brought fame to Jones. ## KING TUT'S COFFIN MARVEL OF BEAUTY

(Associated Press Local Wire.) CAIRO, Egypt, Nov. 12.—The inner coffin of Tutankhamen's sarcophagus, containing the mummy, has been removed from the pharaoh's tomb to that of Zeti II, nearby, for examination.

The coffin, which is of human shape, with a painted face, believed to represent the features of the young king himself, is one of the most beautiful pieces of work discovered by Egyptologists.

The mummy, however, was found to be adhering to the sarcophagus, owing to liquid poured over it in the ceremonies whereby the pharaoh was dedicated as a god.

All those present at the removal of the sarcophagus from the tomb were greatly impressed with the richness and majesty of the art lavished upon it by the ancient Egyptians. Several days of extremely careful work will be required to detach the mummy safely from the adhering shell.

## DOUGLAS COUNTY SEVENTH DEBTOR IN STATE LOANS

(Associated Press Local Wire.) SALEM, Ore., Nov. 12.—With loans from the common school fund of the state aggregating \$596,754, Union county is the heaviest borrower among all the counties of the state from that fund, says a statement prepared by G. G. Brown, clerk of the state land board.

At the close of business October 30, the total loans from the school fund were \$6,581,412.85, while rural credit loans aggregated \$421,824.51. In loans from the school fund Wheeler county is second with \$424,045.

Marion county's loans from the school fund are \$278,993.13 and from the rural credits fund \$29,205.90. Lane county has loans aggregating \$113,266 from the school fund and \$4,791.91 from the rural credits fund. Jackson county has

borrowed \$202,220 from the school fund and \$21,404.51 from the rural credits fund. Deschutes county's loans from the two funds are \$95,270 and \$4,821.69 respectively and Umatilla county's loans from the two funds are \$217,405 and \$4,526.58 respectively. Douglas county has borrowed \$66,654 from the school fund and \$19,212.95 from the rural credits fund. Multnomah county has borrowed \$116,724 and \$4,793.31 from the two funds.
