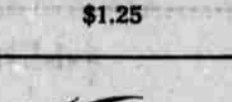

ASHLAND NORMAL SCHOOL JOBS LET TO FOUR BIDDERS

(Associated Press Leased Wire.) SALEM, Ore., Nov. 13—Contracts amounting to \$139,477 for construction of a new state normal school building at Ashland were awarded by the board of regents of the school, meeting here today.

Construction of the building will begin within a few days, it was announced, and the building completed by June 1. It will be made of reinforced concrete, with a stucco exterior and tile roof. It will measure 241 feet in length by 60 feet in width. There will be two full floors and a partial basement.

The building will contain an auditorium capable of accommodating 600 persons, and having 17 class rooms, a library, and four recitation rooms. Contracts were awarded to the following firms:

General construction—Transhell and Parelius, Portland, \$109,972.

Heating and ventilating—Rush-Hill-Hastorf-Lord Co., Portland \$22,107.

Plumbing—Modern Plumbing & Heating Company, Medford, \$2,895.

Writing—National Electric Company, Portland, \$4,609.
