DAMAGE SUIT IS HEARD IN CIRCUIT COURT

A verdict of \$258 in favor of Louis Pelland was awarded by the jury yesterday in the case of Pelland against J. L. Chambers. The suit originated in an automobile accident which occurred just south of Roseburg several months ago. Pelland sought damages in the amount required to repair his car, which was badly wrecked. The case of Tufts against Wicks which was started following the damage case, resulted in a non-suit. The court this morning heard the evidence in the case of T. F. Epping against Charles A. Brand. In this suit Mr. Epping is endeavoring to collect damages growing out of injuries sustained when he was struck by a car driven by Mr. Brand. He claims that the driver of the car was speeding and other wise driving in a careless and negligent manner.
