INTERNATIONAL LIVESTOCK SHOW OPENS IN CHICAGO

CHICAGO, Nov. 28.—The aristocracy of the barnyard passes in review today at the opening of the 26th annual International Livestock Exposition.
Cattle from virtually all parts of the United States and Canada, horses, sheep and swine representing 26 breeds, are included in the 11,500 head of animals exhibited. Hay, grain and small seed displays number 5,000.
A collegian judging contest, with teams of five students from many of the biggest universities of the United States, and the Ontario Agricultural College, officially opens the exposition.
Two girls, Miss Ethel Bonnell of the University of Illinois and Miss Mary E. Hayes, of the University of Kansas, are on the judging teams of their respective schools.
Farm girls and boys are entered in the junior feeding contest to display stock fed by themselves. The exhibit includes 23 baby hives, most of them weighing 1,000 pounds each, all of which celebrate their first birthday during the show.
Outstanding among cattle entries is the Prince of Wales "King of the Paries," undefeated champion bull. The prince's Canadian farm entry also includes a number of short horns, a breed in the majority among the exhibits.
Among the judges who will start their assaying Monday are Robert L. Duncan, of Portland, Ore., Scotland and J. Egerton, Queen of Kent, England. South America is represented by Pedro La Cau and Eduardo Crouse of Buenos Aires. The White House will be represented by William M. Jardine, secretary of agriculture.

AGGIES STAR END, WARD, OUT OF GAME; INJURED

CORVALLIS, Ore., Nov. 28.—Dallas Ward, Oregon Aggie first string end and star pass receiver, is definitely out of the lineup for the game with Southern California. Coach Paul Schissler announced today. Ward was injured in the first half of the Oregon game and was not used at all against Idaho. It was thought the injury was healing satisfactorily, but the hope of his return next Saturday was abandoned when his attempt to participate in practice revealed that he could not safely be used.
With Ward out, Robbins and Logan, both in their first year on the regular squad, will fill the wing positions. These two performed creditably against Oregon and Idaho. The loss of Ward, however, materially lessens the Aggie's chances against the strong Trojans. Every other first string man is expected to be in top form.

FATAL STORMS IN SOUTHERN EUROPE

(Associated Press Special Wire.)
NAPLES, Nov. 28.—A tidal wave sweeping during a terrific storm has devastated the town of Badarna, in Calabria, near the Strait of Messina. The nearby port of Monteleone di Calabria also suffered heavily. No estimate of casualties is available.
LISBON, Portugal, Nov. 28.—Enormous damage and at least some casualties have been caused by torrential rains which fell in Portugal for 24 hours, beginning Thursday night.
By noon yesterday Lisbon was flooded, transportation was interrupted in several districts and many houses collapsed. Numbers of coastal vessels are reported missing and loss of life is feared.
Sebutal, opposite Lisbon, was under water and the only transportation was by boat.
