## CHINESE, FEARING RUSS, PUT THE U. S. GUARD UNDER FIRE

(Associated Press Leased Wire.)

PEKING, Dec. 11.—Eight American passengers were on board the international train which left for Tientsin with a detachment of American infantry as a special guard. The train reached Yangtsun this morning. Four miles to the south General Liching-Ling's troops fired on it. The official report alleges that the Chinese feared an enemy ruse in the use of foreign flags to cover the approach of General Feng Yu-Hsiang's armored train. The train returned to Yangtsun, where some of the passengers tramped several miles and secured motor cars in which to proceed to Tientsin.

TIENTSIN, China, Dec. 11.—The forces of General Li Ching-Ling, civil governor of Chihli province, defeated an advance column of the Kuomintang army (followers of General Feng Yu-Hsiang) near Manchang yesterday in an all day battle.

The railways near this city have been cut and Peking-Tientsin motor road destroyed in several places.

Manchang is to the south west of Tientsin, in the area where Li-Ching-Ling troops are in contact with forces advancing against him from Honan.

The main scene of fighting in the Tientsin sector has been to the north and northwest in the vicinity of Yangtsun. Advances reaching the Japanese foreign office late last night and forwarded in a dispatch from Tokyo, said Li had suffered a "severe defeat." This apparently had reference to the northern or principal zone of fighting.
