(Associated Press Local Wire.) BELFAST, Dec. 15.—Members of the "special" constabulary today seized the Prince's dock barracks in Belfast, declaring they would hold the buildings pending a satisfactory reply to their demands for compensation for their disbandment under the new Irish agreement.

The action of the special constables are demanding a bonus of 200 pounds of income tax for each man because of disbandment and this if granted must be borne by the exchequer of the northern Irish government.
