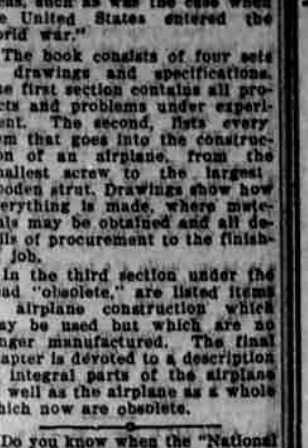
WAR BOOK AT McCOOK FIELD AS THE KEY TO NEXT AIR WARFARE

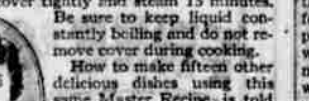
